

Standard tall fescue. Very durable. Tolerates daily wear. Fast growth. Excellent recovery from injury. Coarse texture. Medium green color. Tolerates up to 40% shade. Also available in soilless Lite Sod



Dwarf tall fescue. Durable. Tolerates weekend activity levels. Slightly reduced growth rate. Good injury recovery. Medium/coarse texture. Medium dark green. Tolerates 25% shade.

All members of the Marathon Family stay green year-round and varying Southern California climates and soils.



Extra dwarf tall fescue. Use ornamentally where there are low activity levels. Slow injury recovery. Substantially reduced mow clippings. Medium/fine texture. Dark green. Do not use in shade.



Pureblue is a 100% elite bluegrass blend. Fine textured, dense, elegant appearance. Requires regular care. Does best in moderate coastal areas; avoid inland valleys and warm, arid regions. Requires well-drained soils and does not tolerate much shade or salinity. Green yearround. Available only in soil-less Lite Sod



Ryeblue is 80% bluegrass and 20% perennial rye. Fine textured, dense, elegant appearance. Requires regular care. Does best in moderate coastal areas; avoid inland valleys and warm, arid regions. Requires well-drained soils and does not tolerate much shade or salinity. Green year-round. Available only in soil-less Lite

### Marathon Lite Sod

Marathon Lite is soil-less semihydroponically grown dwarf tall fescue sod. The growth media is a mixture of green waste mulch and recycled wood chips. It is spread on beds covered with a plastic barrier sheet. As the sod grows, the roots are forced laterally by the barrier to form a clean naturally interwoven mat. Sod pieces are lighter weight and are harvested in 2 ft. x 4 ft. pieces.

#### **GreenWave**™

A blend of creeping red fescue. Often seen on unmowed slopes. It can also be used in any ornamental area where a mounding ground cover effect is desired. Can be cut at 2" for a traditional turf appearance. However, it is not as durable as Marathon® varieties in lawn application and we recommend it be limited to areas where high shade will not support the Marathon® varieties.



#### St. Augustine

Very coarse thick stemmed runners. Used primarily where shade tolerance is the top priority. Native to the southern United States where humid conditions do not permit cool-season lawn varieties to flourish. Considerable thatching. Requires concrete borders for containment. Dormant in winter.



Hybrid Bermuda. Excellent as athletic field or recreational turf. Often used on golf course putting greens. Very dense, low-growing, fine textured. With consistent care and trimming will create an attractive "manicured" look. Develops thatch. Requires concrete borders for containment. Becomes dormant in winter.

# Zovsia Tenuifolia

An ornamental grass with a unique, rolling appearance typically used in oriental garden settings or as a ground cover. Usually left unmowed for a freeform, natural look. Extremely slow growing and fine textured. Dormant in
